Directions: Design a poster for a color principles term to share with your classmates.

Step 1: See your teacher to select a term for your poster. My word is _____.

Step 2: Select the program you will use to design your poster. You may use Word, Publisher, PowerPoint, or other print layout and design publication.

Step 3: Use WordArt or a large size font (approximately size 72) to key the word across the top of the page.

Step 4: Use size a minimum font size of 48 for the definition of the word.

Step 5: Add a graphic to represent the word and definition. The graphic should be an example of the term. You may use more than one graphic.

Step 6: Print the poster to the color printer or display the poster on your monitor to share with others.

Step 7: Present the term and definition and explain the example to your classmates. Complete the terminology worksheet as you discuss the terms with your classmates.

Poster Term	The term is located at the top of the page in WordArt or large size font. The definition is typed in a large size font (at least 24). The font is clear and easy to read. The term definition is correct.	20	/20
Poster Design	The poster is well-designed and there is an appropriate balance of white space, text and graphics. The graphic represents the term well. The colors used are easy to read and represent the term well.	15	/15
